

Powder Ridge Ski Racing Program Code of Conduct

Know, teach and demonstrate the Skier's Responsibility Code:

1. Always stay in control, and be able to stop or avoid other people or objects.
2. People ahead of you have the right of way. It is your responsibility to avoid them.
3. You must not stop where you obstruct a trail, or are not visible from above.
4. Whenever starting downhill or merging into a trail, look uphill and yield to others.
5. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. Keep off closed trails and out of closed areas.
7. Prior to using any lift, you must have the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.

Reckless Skiing- There is zero tolerance for fast skiing in slow zones. Leave plenty of space when passing a slower skier/snowboarder. The skier/rider in front has priority –do not endanger others.

Lift/ Lift Line Conduct- No Jumping from lift, fighting or verbal abuse. Preferred Ski School Lift Lines will be used for Ski School/Race Program only. Family members & friends are not allowed in designated ski school lines and any misconduct in these lines will not be tolerated. Participants are not authorized to use the ski school line unless they are with a Coach.

Skiing Closed Trails/ Ducking Ropes –Trails are closed for a reason. Closed trails are closed trails period! There is zero-tolerance for being caught skiing on closed trails or terrain. Consequences for doing so well result in having you pass revoked immediately.

Respect–All participants will show respect for Powder Ridge property and ALL employees. Respect fellow teammates, officials and coaching staff. Show good sportsmanship at all times and be courteous and honest with others and one's self.

Powder Ridge Race team will be a safe place to learn and grow. All participants will protect the emotional and physical well being of their teammates. Bragging, Taunting or Bullying will not be tolerated. Participants who repeatedly fail to exemplify the highest standards of Friendship and Sportsmanship will receive verbal and written warnings and may be dismissed from the team if their behavior is not corrected. The same applies to any behavior that reflects poorly on Powder Ridge.

Helmets are mandatory for all athletes for training sessions, as well as, all of the events in which we participate. No athlete will be allowed on the hill without a helmet. No exceptions. We mandate the use of helmets for all program participants regardless of age ability and accomplishments. Must meet **USSA** regulations per discipline.

You are representing Powder Ridge and when competing away from Powder Ridge you will follow other resorts code of conduct.
