

## Camping Rules & Regulations

- Quiet hours are from 10 p.m. to 8 a.m.
- Maximum of six people permitted per campsite.
- Your site is assigned when you arrive. The easiest way to camp near your friends is to arrive together.
- Only one vehicle is allowed per campsite.
- Head in parking only, all vehicles and items must fit within their spot. Do not impose upon neighboring sites or the fire lane.
- No draining of gray water or holding tank. No dumping or leaching of RV waste. An onsite RV servicing vendor may be available for a fee, contact information provided upon check-in.
- Only camping attendees with a valid camping wristband may enter the camping areas.
- If you arrive with more than one vehicle, you will need to purchase **Overnight Parking Passes** for additional vehicles.
- No kegs of beer permitted in the parking lot or camping areas.
- All Pets must be leashed. You must clean up after your pet on all surfaces throughout the resort.
- No ground or open fires. Cooking fires are permitted, but they must be above ground in approved grills, smokers, etc. Never leave fires unattended.
- One cooking appliance permitted per campsite. No flammable liquids permitted. Maximum amount of propane may not exceed 48 pounds capacity. Cooking appliances permitted between 7 a.m. and 10 p.m. only. Do not leave cooking appliances unattended. Do not dump hot coals on the ground or in trash barrels. Dispose of hot coals and ash in designated coal barrels only.
- No flags or structures may be erected within 100 feet of power lines.
- No all-terrain vehicles, golf carts or motorized two-wheel bikes are permitted.
- No sky lanterns, candles, fireworks or any types of explosives.
- No Swimming or Bathing in the pond or streams.
- Resort buildings - except the main lodge and rentals building - are off limits to campers unless accompanied by resort personnel.
- Your credit card will be held on file and charged if there are damages to the lodge, restrooms, showers or any items within the resort.
- Guests and vehicles subject to search.
- No glass containers, weapons, illegal drug paraphernalia or drugs allowed. Prohibited items list subject to change.

Powder Ridge Mountain Park & Resort is not responsible for damage to personal property. Renter assumes responsibility for theft and vandalism of tent during the time of the rental period. Renter shall indemnify and hold us harmless from all loss resulting there of; including damages or loss caused by fire, water, theft or vandalism. This liability will not exceed the period of the rental agreement.
